This booklet aims to help children take part in the Eucharist service. It includes prayers and responses so that the children can join in.


Please take this booklet home, personalise and colour in the pictures, and bring it back to the next service.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.




We pray together and say:


Dear Lord and Father,

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.


The priest receives and blesses the bread and wine
