**Christian Aid Week 10-16 May 2021.** We've just had a wet, wet, wet bank holiday Monday - very British, you might say, but Rose in eastern Kenya would give anything for our rain. There the people are already in the grip of climate change, with severe drought and unpredictable weather, destroying crops, cattle, and livelihoods. Rose, aged 68, walks a six hour round trip to collect water for her family. If only they could afford to build a water dam to conserve what rainfall there is, it would make a huge difference to her life and that of her family and community.
