**PAAWS walk around Downham in the Ribble Valley Wed 19<sup>th</sup> Jan 2022**—The first PAAWS walk of 2022 will be from the beautiful village of Downham through fields and meadows, tracking along the base of Pendle Hill and finishing back in Downham. The walk is gentle with only low stiles but can be muddy especially in January so boots are a necessity. Dogs will need to be kept on their leads as we walk through farmland plus one section on a narrow lane. Distance – 6 miles Start time – 10.00 a.m. Duration – 3 to 4 hours Meet – Downham Carpark (OS ref 785442 / BB7 4BN) There is no access to the village from the A59 despite the OS map

suggesting otherwise so head for the village of Gisburn and follow the road signs from there. Entering the village from the Gisburn side drop down the hill past the Assheton Arms and turn right over the beck, then first right into the carpark. There is no sign to mark the carpark so it's not terribly visible until you arrive in it! There are toilet facilities in the carpark which are free as is the carpark. We will have a refuelling stop for a snack somewhere along the way. If you intend joining us for this walk please let Nick Walker know either by e-mail
