New to the Priory—A warm welcome if you are new to Lancaster Priory. There are a number of opportunities to join with community, study and social groups for all ages and to stay in touch via digital newsletters and Facebook Groups, as well as our pages on Facebook, Twitter and Instagram. Communion—From Sunday the 22nd of May we will be reintroducing the common cup/the chalice. Intinction will be strictly not allowed by anyone. It is perfectly valid to receive communion in one kind and you may prefer to continue to do this. Those administering will wear masks.

Asylum Seekers—The Home Office has recently relocated over 200 asylum seekers (men) to Lancaster. Whilst they have accommodation and meals provided, they have no money and therefore cannot buy essential items such as toiletries. Nor are they able to supplement their meals which for some are proving very inadequate. . A collection will be here in church next Sunday - May 22nd - inviting members of the Priory family to bring to services across that day toiletries or snack items which will bring real comfort to these strangers in our midst. There will be a collection box at the back of the church. So we're asking for the following: - Men's toiletries, in particular toothpaste, shaving cream and toothbrushes; also moisturisers and lip salve as their skin is bad after crossing the channel in small boats - also welcome are men's socks (new, please) - Snack items such as multipack crisps and chocolate bars (these can be split for men to share but everything needs to be individually wrapped); small packs of dried fruits and nuts; small juice cartons with straws.
