Lancaster City Museums have been awarded a National Lottery grant -

A £68,512 grant from The National Lottery Heritage Fund will support a project that aims to make its museums fit for the future. In addition to £20,000 from the Council's own reserves, the funding will kickstart a review to develop a suite of options for the City, Maritime, Cottage & King's Own Royal Regiment museums. This will ask whether, whilst preserving the heritage in the collections, development work could increase accessibility and environmental sustainability of the museums. A short survey has been put together to gather people's views on what they value most, or areas that could be improved, they would appreciate all views please. The survey is available at
