Our charity of the month – The PCC gives to several charities and each month we highlight and pray for one of them.

This month we remember Reaching the Unreached (RTU) which is a far-reaching grassroots organisation working in rural villages in South India to help the poorest most marginalised people. It provides family life for abandoned children, food for hungry families, water for thirsty villagers, opportunities for rural women, homes for the homeless and education for the poorest children and adults.

Announcement of the future of the VAT refund Scheme -

The Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme will now be extended into the next financial year, with a new cap of £25,000 per place, providing £23 million so that thousands of historical buildings, including churches, synagogues, mosques and temples, can carry out restoration work. The temporary extension of the scheme recognises that listed places of worship represent an important part of UK heritage and provide spaces for communities to come together. The Dept. for Culture, Media & Sport received more than three hundred letters on the topic, and some three thousand letters were sent to MPs.
