Our charity of the month – The PCC gives to several charities and each month we highlight and pray for one of them. The Priory's Charity of the Month for April is RAIS, Refugee, Advice and Information Service, which is a local charity based in Lancaster but also covering Morecambe. As the name suggests, it provides services and support to Refugees and Asylum Seekers who have arrived in our area. It has paid staff and volunteers who all give unstintingly to help people in great need.

Electoral Roll Renewal Year — This is wiped clean every 5 years and we start again! The role is therefore now open to you to register. Why? Because being on the Church Electoral Roll is a way of demonstrating your willingness to help shape the future of the Church, not just locally, but nationally and internationally. It also enables you to participate and vote in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), which elects members to the Parochial Church Council (who are in effect the legal trustees of the church).
